Proposals include the type of workshop proposed, a brief description, expected outcomes, the anticipated audience, and 1 or 2 potential weeks the workshop may be offered. Summer workshops may be held online or in-person on campus.

For the summer of 2025, proposals will be reviewed and selected in March by the CLTA and the Instructional Support Committee. Proposers are contacted to finalize the details.

Registration instructions on **GLADIS** will be provided in May.

Workshop Guidelines:

- 1) A workshop 'day' is broadly defined as approximately 3 hours of meeting time plus other assignments or readings.
