## **Pedagogical Goals**

- 1. to familiarize students with a substantial and diverse body of texts in English or that inform English-language literary works
- 2. to enable students to analyze texts from a range of critical and theoretical perspectives
- 3. to train students in the techniques of academic research in English
- 4. to develop the skills that contribute to persuasive argumentation and stylistic elegance
- 5. to develop in students the skills required to contribute by creative expression to the traditions they study
- 6. to familiarize students with the theories and practices of inter- or multidisciplinary scholarship
- 7. to have each English major develop proficiency in reading literature in at least one language other than English
- 8. to develop in students the skills of revision and rigorous self-criticism
